Enrich & Explore (Years 1 & 2)

All pupils within Years 1 and 2 complete our innovative 'Enrich and Explore' programme. The programme runs across the two year groups and covers a range of subjects including:

Future Skills (Years 3, 4, 5 & 6)

Pupils within Years 3 to 6 progress onto our 'Future Skills' course which covers a range of modules including:

- Problem Solving
- Philosophical Enquiry
- Independent Study
- General Knowledge
- Communication
- Integrated Task Module—combines each of the above modules into one combined task

The following clubs are available for parents who need to arrange care for their child outside of School hours:

Fun Club

Fun Club caters for children in Pre-Prep, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 after the school day until 6pm (at an additional cost). For families in receipt of the Government's childcare funding (30 hours per week), some extended hours are covered for children not attending all 5 days of the week). The children are provided with a snack and drink and then they relax, play and enjoy being with friends in a caring and stimulating environment.

Homework Club

Homework Club is available until 6pm (at an additional cost) and pupils are supported during this time to complete homework. They are provided with a snack and a drink before beginning their homework.
