Assessment Days for 2026 Entry to Seniors:

Year 5 Assessment Days - 16/17/18 June 2025

Year 6 Assessment Days - January 2026

Seniors has been over-subscribed in recent years and early application is strongly encouraged. For those applying for entry to Year 7, bursaries are considered twice during the year; in the Michaelmas Term for those who have undertaken the Year 5 Assessment; and in February following the Year 6 Assessment.*

* Families should be aware that dependent on the outcome of the June Year 5 assessment days, there may be fewer places and limited bursary funding left for those attending the January Year 6 assessment days.
