Reception, Years 1 & 2 Clubs & Activities

Beavers (Ages 6 to 8)

Beavers is part of the Scouts organisation and is open to girls and boys aged between 6 and 8 years of age. The aim of Beavers is to teach a host of new skills to all children while maintaining a theme of adventure and fun.

Story Seekers Club (Year 1)

Story Seekers Club will introduce the concept of reading, and looking at books, for pleasure. New stories will be read each week with an associated activity to follow.

Nature Club (Reception and Year 1)

In Nature Club, children will explore the world outdoors through fun activities. Planting, painting and much more!

Squirrels (4-6 year olds)

'Squirrels' has been created by the Scouts for 4 to 6 year olds, building skills and preparing children for moving up to Beavers and beyond. The aim of the provision is to help young people gain skills for life at a time when it matters most and where it is most needed.

Every week, Squirrels will gather to grow and learn their way through lots of different games and activities. The one hour sessions will be a brilliant opportunity for young people to take their first step into being part of Scouts, and they'll help everyone get ready for the adventure of school too.

Sessions will be packed with outdoor activities, fun, games, badges, laughter, and so much more to help our youngest members learn the skills they need for life. As in other Scout sections, Squirrels will work their way through activity badges which they will be awarded upon completion. The badges have been designed as part of an age appropriate program of activities, which encourages community and home learning.

Please note that there is a charge of £50 for this club.

Construction Club (Reception)

There will be a Construction after school club on Thursday afternoons for Reception children. The primary aim of this club is to have fun in a safe and nurturing environment. Children will begin to develop a range of skills in order to build their confidence and self-esteem whilst working as part of a team.

About the Clubs - Juniors

Beavers (Ages 6 - 8) - Monday

Beavers is part of the Scouts organisation and is open to girls and boys aged between 6 and 8 years of age. The aim of Beavers is to teach a host of new skills to all children while maintaining a theme of adventure and fun.

Year 3 Crafting

Throughout this club, children will be introduced to a range of crafting ideas, including outdoor activities, perfect for beginners.

Girls' Cricket Club - Tuesday

The Girls' Cricket Club will run throughout the Summer term with the focus on improvement and fun. Generally, sessions will start with some simple hand-eye co-ordination drills and swiftly move onto games. The club will generally take place up on the School Field although **pick-up will be at 5pm from the Prep playground.**

Cubs (Ages 8 - 10) - Wednesday

Cubs is part of the Scouts organisation and is open to girls and boys aged between 8 and 10 years of age. For Cubs, excitement and adventure are key. The Cubs programme offers a huge variety of activities surrounding areas of fitness, global issues and beliefs; whilst allowing them to be creative.

Year 6 Cricket Club

Run on Mondays from 8 to 9am in the Senior School Sports Hall (or maybe up at Mac Field in the outdoor nets), Year 6 Cricket Club will run throughout the Summer term in preparation and practice for the cricket season. The focus will be on hard ball cricket, predominantly with use of the nets. Appropriate clothing should be worn and all equipment will be provided by the School as necessary.

Prep Orchestra (Years 3 to 6)

Prep Orchestra is open to children in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 who play an orchestral instrument. Rehearsals take place after school until 5pm every Thursday during term time in the Rehearsal Studio. The children learn to play a variety of genres of music and will perform in the School Christmas and Summer Concerts.

Intermediate Band

This band is for woodwind, drums, guitars and keyboard (piano) players and will take place in the top floor rehearsal space. Members should meet in the rehearsal studio, together with Orchestra for first few weeks. Note, Year 5/6 members must also attend Prep Orchestra every week.
